Tier 2 and 3 Resources

Mustang P.R.I.D.E (Check-in/Check-out)

- This daily intervention will provide your child with regular reminders, feedback and support in order to help him/her achieve maximum success following Monee Mustang behavior expectations- Be Kind, Be Responsible, Be Safe-at all times. Your child's teacher will rate his/her behavior according to a daily behavior progress report. You can expect this progress report to come home with your child each night. Your child's progress will be monitored on a regular basis in order to further promote their continued success.
- Your child will also be assigned to a teacher mentor to check in and out with daily. The role of this person is to provide extra encouragement and praise while reviewing your child's daily progress. As your child succeeds in meeting his/her goals, he/she may earn incentives periodically. Incentives may include items such as Mustang Money (to spend at the school store), pencils, piece of candy, etc.

• Social Academic Instructional Groups (S.A.I.G)

- It is our goal at Monee Elementary for all students to achieve not only academic success, but experience positive, social and emotional growth as well. To support that goal, various skill groups meet throughout the school year. Each small group of students will meet during the school day for a series of 8 sessions, generally 20-30 minutes each.
